Friday May 2nd

La Strada (1954) won the Academy Award for Best Foreign Film in 1956 directed by Federico Fellini and starring Giulietta Masina, Anthony Quinn and Richard Basehart. Apparently this is Pope Francis's favorite film of all time! Unrated, mature audience suggested.

Friday May 9th

Mary and Max (2009) Claymation film with voices by Toni Collette and Philip Seymour Hoffman. Written and directed by Adam Elliot, who also won an Oscar in 2003 for Best Animated Short Film for his Harvie Krumpet. Unrated, mature audience suggested.

Friday May 16th

WADJDA (2012) is not only the first feature film shot by a female Saudi filmmaker but is also the first feature film shot entirely in Saudi Arabia. Written and directed by Haifaa Al Mansour and starring Waad Mohammed, Reem Abdullah and Abdullrahman Al Gohani. Rated PG.
