

# BOXBOROUGH: POPULATION TRENDS

**82%** of Boxborough households own their homes, which is about 1.3 times the rate of Middlesex County.

**20%** of Boxborough residents are foreign born as compared to 22 percent in Acton and 10 percent in Littleton.

**3%** of households live under the poverty line, which is two-fifths the rate of poverty in Middlesex County, and one-quarter of the rate in Massachusetts.

The median household income in Boxborough is


**\$107,000**


## Educational Attainment




## Reported Occupations

## Affordability



The Location Affordability Index is a measure of the combined costs of housing and transportation. The average combined cost of housing and transportation for a 2-person household in Boxborough is roughly \$36,878. By comparison, the cost in Sudbury is \$41,812, the cost in Frammingham is \$34,229, and the cost in Boston is \$31,267. (Source: HUD).
