Minutes

- Minutes from July 10th, 2014 were accepted with modifications, submitted by John Fallon.
- Frank Powers met with Cindy Worthington Berry to discuss the need to identify people in town who could provide simple handyman services to seniors. Cindy will check with her "Call to Care" group at the Church. The church at one time had a list of people who could provide services and she indicated they would like to pursue it again. Frank will work with the Board of Selectman about the Council on Aging providing names of people (handyman) to seniors.
- The UCC Church agrees with the COA that it would be desirable to have the kitchen at the Community Center modified to enable food preparation. However a major stumbling block is the septic system. Frank will follow up with the Nashoba Board of Health.
- Frank Powers our MART representative gave an update on the agency. It is experiencing some fiscal difficulties. The town is committed to keeping our senior van service running smoothly.
- Susan Page will write press releases to the Beacon and Action Unlimited about the upcoming Mastering Tech Tools at the library.
