- Nashoba Associated Boards of Health offers residents of the Town of Boxborough access to a
 Public Health Team, which consists of two Registered Nurses (RN) and one Licensed Social
 Worker (LCSW). The Public Health Team is available Monday-Friday from 8-4:30. (There are also
 two dental hygienists that provide primary preventive dental care to grades K-5 in all of our
 school districts throughout the year.)
- The Public Health Team offers:
 - ➤ Home visits to assess general well-being and safety (short-term)
 - Support and assistance with coordinating care and services for those in need
 - Drop-in clinics
 - > Immunization programs
 - > Outreach and education via participation in health fairs/seminars/talks, etc.
 - > Community partnership via involvement in the Well Being Committee
 - Community support to address questions/concerns
 - Communicable disease investigation and follow-up
 - Hoarding Outreach Program
 - Consultation for a possible Home Health or Hospice referral to Nashoba Nursing Service and Hospice
- The services of the Public Health Team are free to at-risk and under-served residents of Boxborough through an agreement between the Town and the Nashoba Associated Boards of Health.
