

Public Participation Policy

It shall be the policy of the Board of Selectmen to set aside fifteen minutes at the beginning of each meeting for public participation. The purpose of public participation shall be to afford the general public an opportunity to ask questions on an ongoing basis. If a citizen has a problem or a question which will require action or is likely to take more than fifteen minutes, the citizen should request to be placed on the agenda for a future meeting.

This period of time shall not be used for any standing committees, commissions or boards. Those groups shall ask the Town Administrator for agenda time and shall abide by the scheduled appointment.

Every effort will be made to get the requesting party or parties agenda time as soon as possible.
