

Help Develop Affordable Housing in Boxborough!

Volunteers Needed

Last year, the Boxborough Housing Board purchased approximately 13.5 acres of land located on 72 Stow Road, opposite the Sheriff's Meadow and Tisbury Meadows communities in the Town Center District. Using this land, the Housing Board intends provide to affordable housing (not necessarily Chapter 40B affordable housing) that will enhance the presently available housing options in Boxborough.

The Housing Board seeks community and professional input regarding design options, which may include an alternative use of some kind, such as a community center. To that end, the Board of Selectmen established a Concept Development Committee for the Stow Road project. The Concept Development Committee members will serve for about a year, commencing in the earlier part of next year. The committee will seek community opinion, determine housing needs, and examine practical factors that may affect the development. Its objective is to establish desirable development alternatives, which will be used to prepare specifications for a building contractor.
