

## **ABCC Minutes 2012/01/09**

Greg Hutchins gave the Treasurer's Report: Three 2011 Grantees still have not filed for reimbursement.

Barbara reported that she had sent out the last disapproval letters and that no requests for reconsideration had been received.

Ming, Marion and Pascale have completed data entry of grant information for the MCC.

Council discussed the possible purchase of a sculpture by Madeleine Lord or Linda Hoffman for the Boxborough Library. (Works of both artists were in the recent Art of Recycling Exhibition at the library.) Barbara will contact the Boxborough Library Trustees to see if they are interested in possible purchase of a sculpture by the ABCC for the library.

We also discussed possibility of partially funding Yin Peet's WW1 Memorial sculpture which she carved for the Town of Acton.

Barbara moved that the Council give Yin Peet \$750 for her work on the sculpture. Anne seconded the motion. The Council voted unanimously in favor. Greg will disburse the funds.

Council discussed Movies in May film series to be held at Acton Town Hall on Friday evenings of May 4<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup>. Barbara will discuss the use of the room with the Town of Acton. Greg will speak with Maureen at Boxborough Library about possible films she would like to acquire.

Discussed possible dates for Grantee reception at Boxborough Library either March 2<sup>nd</sup> or April 27<sup>th</sup>.
