Dennis called the meeting to order at 7:30 PM.

Motion was made by Norm, seconded by Dennis and unanimously voted to approve the minutes of April 4, 2012.

Motion was made by Dennis, seconded by David, and unanimously voted to pay Oxbow Associates \$180.00.

Motion was made by Dennis, seconded by David, and unanimously voted to pay New England Wild Flower Society \$4,060.00.

Liz Markiewicz, LanSCom, inquired by email about the availability of funds for purchase of gravel for trails at Steele Farm. Dennis will reply that \$500.00 is available in maintenance.

Dennis will follow up on the Open Space and Recreation grant form with the Town Planner.

Charlene and Norm reported on the Flerra Meadows site visit with DPW and recommend the following:

1. Keep the trail 12 ft. wide or less.
2. Relocate the trail to the north of the tree toward the cemetery.
3. After Fifer's Day, a 12 ft. strip can be mowed along the pond and along the fence by the driveway

Motion was made by Dennis, seconded by David and unanimously voted to approve the following Certificates of Compliance for 34 Massachusetts Avenue / Olympia Realty: 113-186, 113-309, and BWB 94-01.

Norm reviewed the trail easements on the Fabian property. The Commission approved a letter to send to Kopelman and Paige regarding relocating the Fisk trail.

Motion was made by David, seconded by Dennis, and unanimously voted to adjourn at 8:50 PM.
