CPC discussion: Potential projects to ask for CPA Funding

We have submission deadlines for CPC coming up. We have two items to put forth:

- 1) Funding for the initial survey evaluation for the basketball and tennis court at Liberty Field
- 2) Request for \$40,000 to help fund the TJ O'Grady Skate Park in Acton

Motion to put forth 2 requests for CPA funding: \$7,000 for evaluation of the basketball and tennis court and \$40,000 for improvements of the TJ O'Grady Skate Park. Motion accepted and all in favor.
