

Boxborough Conservation Commission
Meeting Minutes
Wednesday
December 17, 2014 Town Hall

Members present: Charlene Golden, Norm Hanover, David Koonce, Dennis Reip (Chair) and Hoff Stuart at 8:40 pm.

Member absent: David Follett

Dennis called the meeting to order at 7:35 pm.

Motion was made by Dennis, seconded by Norm, and unanimously voted 4 - 0 to approve the Certificate of Compliance for file #113-117.

Norm presented the latest draft of the Conservation Commission's letter regarding public access to the Hager-Library parcel from Joseph Road over the 50-foot wide parcel shown on the approved Definitive Subdivision Plan. Motion was made by Norm, seconded by Dennis, and unanimously voted 4 - 0 to approve the letter to the Town Planner, Town Administrator, DPW Director and Board of Selectmen.

Norm reported on graffiti on rocks and trees on the Picnic Street Trust land. This matter is a concern of the Board of Selectmen, since the land is under their care and control.

Charlene reported that the Town Planner is waiting for the next draft update to the OSRP from MAPC.


Dennis reported that the Treasurer is compiling a list of all town-owned parcels obtained through tax foreclosure. The Commission will start ranking parcels for Conservation value at the January 7th meeting.

Hoff Stuart arrived at 8:40 pm. He summarized the proceedings of the SNAG meeting. In particular he mentioned that potential wetlands' impacts were discussed. Several scenarios for the police - fire station arrangement were proposed.

Motion was made by Hoff, seconded by Norm, and unanimously voted 5 - 0 to approve the minutes of December 3, 2014.

Motion was made by Dennis, seconded by Norm, and unanimously voted 5 - 0 to adjourn at 9:47 pm.
