

Boxborough Conservation Commission
Meeting Minutes
Wednesday June 17, 2015 Town Hall

Members present: David Follett, Charlene Golden, Norm Hanover, David Koonce, and Dennis Reip (Chair).

Dennis called the meeting to order at 7:33 pm.

Motion was made by Norm, seconded by Dennis and voted unanimously to approve the corrected minutes of June 3, 2015.

Dennis reported on work by Peter Severance, who is writing a book on the Merrimack River and is gathering data on rare species and priority habitats in connection with his project.

Dennis reported that he still hasn't heard anything from Don McPherson regarding the filing of an RDA for the agricultural work in question at MMAF. Dennis intends to e-mail Mr. McPherson monthly until he receives a reply.

The July 1st meeting is cancelled due to lack of a quorum and any pressing business. If necessary, a meeting will be called July 8th, since a quorum is available then. A quorum is available all other regularly scheduled meetings in July and August.

Charlene reported that the OSRP has been sent to the State for review.

Norm reported that Liz Markiewicz held a LanSCom meeting last Saturday. He reported that no one on the DPW staff has a license for application of herbicides.

The Commission reviewed correspondence from Bruce Hager regarding proposed Steele Farm management. The consensus of Commissioners is that there are concerns over the scope and extent of the proposal, with questions regarding its goals and objectives.

Motion was made by Dennis, seconded by David Follett, and unanimously voted to adjourn at 9:04 pm.
