


Items stolen from Schoolhouse #2, Picnic Street.

- 1) Brass Bell, inscribed with “George Robinson”, as well as date and school



- 2) Brown felt Stetson-type hat.
- 3) 18'x 24" wooden framed picture of Abraham Lincoln.
- 4) Three (3) 5'x8' American Flags with stitched stars
- 5) "76" American flag
- 6) Set of red, white and blue ruffled bunting
- 7) 48 state American flag with wooden pole
- 8) Hand crotchet American Flag (Over 100 years old)
- 9) One dozen (12) quill pens with ink wells.
- 10) Fifteen (15) small chalk board slates
- 11) Three (3) citations for George Robinson from State House
- 12) Five (5) antique canning jars
- 13) Antique lamp. Base is rectangular pink glass. Missing shade.
- 14) Book on antique school games
- 15) Four (4) Barrel hoop and sticks. (game) →
- 16) Top with strings game
