Boxborough trails are marked with brown wooden signs at each entrance.



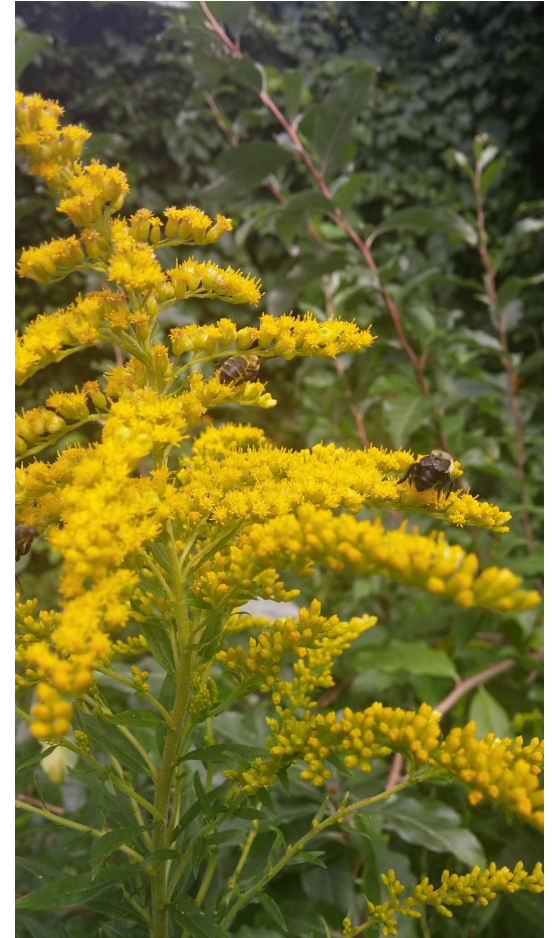
Good Trail Manners (Leave No Trace)
