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### **BOXBOROUGH TO BRIEF ALL ON MBTA ZONING REQUIREMENT**

The Boxborough Town Planner, Simon Corson, will brief a joint Meeting of the Select Board and Planning Board, via Zoom, on Monday, March 14, 2022 at 7 p.m. on the so-called MBTA Zoning which must be adopted by December 31, 2024. Town residents, business owners, and all other interested parties are encouraged to attend.

A presentation on the [Department of Housing and Community Development \(DHCD\) DRAFT Guidelines](#) that require Boxborough to zone a district with multi-family housing as of right. Enacted as part of the [Economic Bond Bill \(House No. 5250\)](#) in January 2021, Section 3A of the M.G.L. c. 40A (the Zoning Act) requires that an [MBTA community](#), such as Boxborough, shall have **at least one zoning district of reasonable size in which multi-family housing is permitted as of right with the minimum gross density of 15 units per acre, contains no age restrictions, and is suitable for families with children.**

**Boxborough is considered an adjacent MBTA community because the Fitchburg-Boston commuter train travels through the northeast portion of Town. Boxborough must allow for at least 750 units (50 acres x 15 units/acre).** Given that Boxborough has no land area within 0.5 mile of a transit station, the multi-family district should be located in an area with reasonable access to a transit station. Failure to create such a district would bar Boxborough from participation in the [Housing Choice Initiative](#), [MassWorks Infrastructure Program](#), and other grant opportunities.
