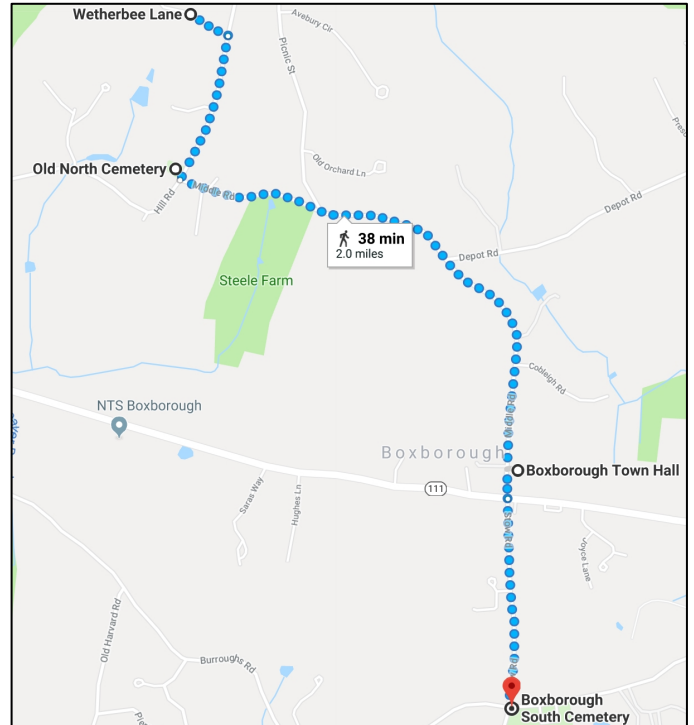


# Boxborough Memorial Day Parade & Ceremony May 29, 2023

- **8:00am** - Marchers must be dropped off by 8am
- **8:15am** - Line up at 8:15 (Hill Rd & Wetherbee Lane).
- **8:30am** - Parade steps off at 8:30 sharp.

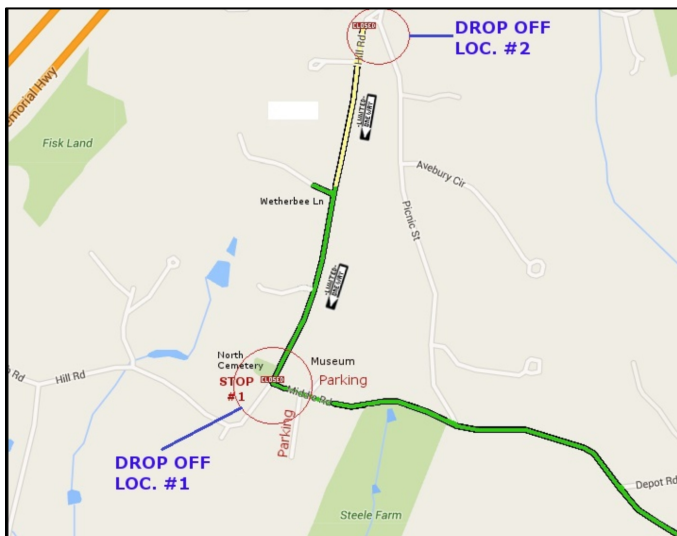
## Parade Route:

- Begins at **Wetherbee Lane** on Hill Road
- Proceeds on **Hill Road** to NORTH CEMETERY (Ceremony #1)
- Turns left on **Middle Road** to TOWN HALL (Ceremony #2)
- Proceeds across Rte 111, onto **Stow Road** to SOUTH CEMETERY (Ceremony #3)

### **Where to watch the Parade:**

Ceremonies take place at North Cemetery, Town Hall, and South Cemetery. There is no parking at North Cemetery, so please advise people not in the parade who want to watch it to park at Town Hall, the church, or on Burroughs Road east of South Cemetery.

### **Non-marchers who wish to follow the parade:**

People are welcome to follow the parade rather than watch in one place. Please follow the parade at the end, however. Walking along the side of band members and others obstructs the view for parade attendees and creates safety concerns.

### **After-Parade Pick up:**

If you are picking up marchers after the parade, please meet them at South Cemetery (corner of Stow and Burroughs Roads).
