Subject: Findings and Recommendation - Boxborough Business Improvement Grant Program - Blossom Bees Honey Co.

On March 20, 2024, we received a revised application for the Boxborough Business Improvements Grant Program, from the applicant business Blossom Bees Honey Co. As per your NOFA, issued on July 29, 2023, I have reviewed the materials submitted, offering the following summary and draft score.

Summary

The applicant has provided a complete application however has not demonstrated the necessary qualities for a match. The proposal entails use of funding to cover costs for: “expanding retail presence through partnerships with local businesses, establishing pop-up shops, enhancing e-commerce capabilities, implementing marketing strategies, and community education efforts, alongside increasing honey production and processing capacity, launching new product lines”. After reviewing the application it seems Blossom Bees Honey Co. wishes to utilize this new position to help the company assist its standing for the community and success online.

It is evident that Blossom Bees Honey Co. is a valued local business and the application provides the necessary details and subject matter for how the use of the funds from Boxborough Business Improvement Grant Program would be used to further the development of an economically vibrant Town Center Village, though it would be outside this specific zone.

Draft Score

Attached you will find a complete draft score of the application. I offer a draft score of 82 points for the proposed application. The application scored most highly in the Priority Goods, Services, or Cultural Business category, as the business falls within the target area of business types and will support neighboring businesses. Further, the business is likely to draw in traffic from outside town boundaries, thus expanding commerce in town.

The proposal does not fall within the proposed Village Center area on the map, however this business proposes a “mobile retail cart” that will operate in different sections of the proposed economic center. While not a new business, the proposed services will be unique to the

community and will result in the expansion of the business. While additional matching funds are provided, the amount provided was not enough to trigger additional points.

Recommendation

Based on the draft score provided, the committee in my view should approve the proposed application as it meets the overarching goal of the Boxborough Business Improvement Grant Program. The committee should first consider whether to amend the draft score, and then whether to issue an award letter. Decision on this application is left to the discretion of the Committee though it is strongly recommended to go forward with this application
