Council on Aging Snow & Hazardous Weather Cancellation Guidelines Classes, Events, & Transportation

As a general guideline the Council on Aging (COA) will follow the Acton-Boxborough Regional School District (ABRSD) to determine when activities should be canceled due to snow or other inclement weather. Check the ABRSD website and Twitter account for weather notifications: www.abschools.org.

- When ABRSD cancels classes due to weather **all COA activities, classes, events, and van service will be canceled for the day.**
- When ABRSD calls for a delayed opening, all **MORNING COA activities, classes, and van service will be canceled.** Afternoon activities will go ahead unless otherwise notified.
- Check the ABRSD website and Twitter account for weather notifications: www.abschools.org.
- COA cancellations will be posted on the COA page of the Town website as an announcement; you may sign up to be emailed announcements by clicking “Subscribe to E-alerts” at the top right corner of the page: www.boxborough-ma.gov/council-on-aging.
- COA cancellations may also be posted on Facebook by the BetteringBoxboroughTogether Facebook page: www.facebook.com/betteringboxboroughtogether.
- Individual COA class instructors, event organizers, and activity leaders may decide to cancel due to the weather even if the school district remains open. In these cases, the instructor/organizer/activity leader is responsible for notifying participants and the COA of cancellation via email or phone as soon as possible. Participants may also call the COA directly to find out if a class or activity has been canceled: 978-264-1730.
- The COA Director may suspend activities or transportation beyond these guidelines if necessary for weather related safety reasons.
